## PURPOSES AND PROCEDURES FOR SECTIONAL SEATING AUDITIONS

For the information of students who are new to MYS, as well as a reminder to everyone, please note the following:

\*\*Sectional seating auditions are held for two purposes. One is to provide students with the opportunity to work closely with the conductor. Each section of the orchestra meets separately with the conductor so that the music can be rehearsed in detail. The second purpose is to determine seating order. In addition to rehearsing with the section, the conductor can make a systematic determination of seating order.

\*\*Sectional seating is scheduled during the regular rehearsal time on Saturday morning in anticipation of 100% participation. If for some *valid reason*, you cannot attend at the assigned time for your section on that day, *it is your responsibility to schedule a make-up time*. The scheduled make-up times are listed above. \*\*If you are ill on the day of scheduled audition and cannot attend, you must call the Concert Manager by 10:00p.m. of that evening to schedule a time before the next scheduled rehearsal.

\*\*Any student who is not heard at their scheduled time or an alternate time as mentioned above, will be heard *will automatically be seated at the end of his/her section*. The only exception is in the event of an emergency preventing you from calling on **January 5<sup>th</sup>**.
